All labor was performed by Wayne’s Roofing Inc. employees Dean Bock, Jeff Bottoms, Jon Burford, Jim Clark, Josh Garrison, Bob Guthrie, Joe Iriarte, Nick Jacobson, Mike Matson, Michael Mintz, Dan Richter, Marshall Whisler and Darren Witham, all of whom are members of Tacoma Roofers and Waterproofers Local 153. Mike Trout, Dan Johnson and Chuck Richmond of WRI were instrumental in organizing the project.

“It gives us great pleasure being able to help out one of our local senior citizens within our community,” said Mike Trout, WRI sales and service representative.
